The second part will consist of a Power Point presentation with a hands-on - an opportunity for the judges to go over some dogs. Area Attractions

Franklin Park - Site of the Historical Marker for the Wisconsin State Dog, the American Water Spaniel and the Chamber of Commerce office.

Hatten Park - Largest city park (120 acres) located on the southwest side of New London. It is where the AWSC National Specialty will be held. It is located on the southwest side of New London on the west side of Werner Allen Road..

Historical Marker - The American Water Spaniel, Wisconsin's Official State Dog, is a special breed developed by the late Dr. Fred Pfeifer, a New London native. The Marker is located in Franklin Park.

Historical Village - It is located in Memorial Park on Montgomery Street. Open June-August. Group tours welcome

Mukwa Wildlife Area - 1,500-acre marshland located just west of New London. It is one of the few remaining "wild" rivers in America. Famous for the annual migration of the walleye, white bass, catfish and spawning sturgeon.

New London Museum and Library - Open to the public this historic library was built in 1914 and remodeled in 1986. The Museum was founded in 1932 by Charles F. Carr, one of the City's first librarians. Located at 406 S. Pearl St. Closed Sat. and Sun. during the Summer.

The Little Wolf River - Famous for its fast clean water. Fish species include small and large-mouth bass, rock bass, northern pike, and trout. Enjoy inner tubing and canoeing or spend some leisure time on the river.

Tri-Rivers Nature Area - The Embarras, Wolf and Shioc Rivers all run through this 25,000 acres of public wildlife. Open year round. Canoeing welcome.

Entry Instructions:

Photographs must be received in hard copy form - no e-mail entries will be accepted. Photos should be no smaller than 5" x 7" and no larger than 11" x 14" (preferably 8" x 10") and preferably matted, not to exceed 1/4 inch thickness. (Mats should be plain and simple as the main judging criteria will be photo quality and composition.) Maximum size for mount board is 12" x 16". No frames allowed. The front of a mounted photo must not have any markings in the frame area around the photo. Photos may not include humans - AWS only, please. No signatures or other identifiers should be visible on any entries.

If you are submitting a photo taken by a professional photographer (other than yourself), we must have a signed release from the photographer or we cannot accept the entry. We reserve the right to switch any photo to a different category than the one submitted.

There is a maximum entry limit of 3 entries per category by the same person. If a photo won a first through third place last year, the photo is not allowed to reenter this year. If the photo did not win a placement, it is allowed to be reentered.

Entry Fee and Deadline:

A completed Photo Contest Entry Form must be received along with a \$5 entry fee (payable to AWSC, Inc.) for each entry listed by July 14th. Up to 5 photos may be listed on an entry form. Each photo must have the category and name of the submitter on the back. All entry fees will go toward the General Fund.
